What is **EmployAbility** Service?

Employability Service is an initiative that works to assist those with a disability/illness or those deemed to need extra support to search for employment within the open labour market

It is a free and confidential service, available to employers, employees and job seekers.

EmployAbility Service opens doors to mainstream employment

It aids people who are job ready to secure and maintain employment while also ensuring that they are being successfully integrated into the workforce.

Who can avail of **EmployAbility** Service?

Those over the age of 18 who genuinely require the initial support of a Job Coach to obtain employment in the open market. Employability Service is also available to those who are currently in paid employment and need our support to maintain their role. This is open to both the employer and the employee.

How does **EmployAbility** Service Work?

PARTICIPANTS

- It is a free, confidential, recruitment service.
- Provides you with a Job Coach to assist you in exploring:
 - Career Options
 - Curriculum Vitae Preparation
 - Work Experience
 - Interview Preparation
 - Suitable Vacancies
- In many cases, the Job Coach will speak to employers regarding employment issues and often act as an intermediary on behalf of the job seeker.
- Once a position is secured, support continues on an ongoing basis depending on the requirement needed. Natural supports are also put in place to assist you to work independently.

How does **EmployAbility** Service Work?

EMPLOYER

- Assess your recruitment needs.
- Assist in the sourcing of suitable employees to fill your position.
- Match your needs as an employer with the skills, knowledge and experience of suitable job seekers.
- Aid with the integration of your new employee into the workplace and onto your staff team.
- Provide support where necessary, with induction, on the job training, evaluation and monitoring.
- Provide you with advice and information on relevant grants and schemes.
